Ted Mullins Scholarship

- **Are available to all dependent children (including legally adopted children) of any active member in good standing (for the past Six months prior to January 1st) of TNBC Chicago Chapter.**
- **Applicant must attend a counseling session with TNBC Chicago Chapter scholarship committee.**
- **Applicant must have at least a 2.6 grade point average.**
- **Award money can be used for books or tuition and will be paid directly to the educational institution.**
- **In an essay format please explain why you feel you should be the recipient of a scholarship in not less than 300 words typed or handwritten and double spaced. Once you have completed the application, submit along with the required essay and a copy of your last report card.**
- **Applicant must have an official school transcript when applying for the scholarship.**
- **Applicant must enroll in a program that is lasting at least 6 months (4yr College, Junior College, Vocational Training, specialized Career Schools).**
- **If applicant is a recurring award recipient, there must be a confirmation of their enrollment in school with a list of courses being taken.**
- **If an applicant transfers or withdraws from school, for any reason, TNBC Chicago Chapter must be notified at once.**
- **Failure to comply with any provisions of these directions or falsifying information will result in automatic disqualification.**
- **The Executive Board of TNBC Chicago Chapter will make the final decision and contact you. Awards will be based on the completed essays including grammar and spelling, and your current grade point average. Only one recipient per household per year.**
- **Award to be given in September and will be acknowledged at the Annual Black Tie Banquet in December.**
